That day a dream was born. And today, you will see the Clydesdale babies, hear about how each is chosen for a parade hitch, learn about how they are reared and see how they live! Enjoy your tour of Warm Springs Ranch!

From the ranch we'll travel on to **Settler's Inn**. Not just lunch, but an experience, enjoy your delicious homemade meal served on blue fleck plates all in a **real log cabin**. It's not just lunch, it's a fun addition to your day!

Next we'll make our way to the **Candy Factory**, a Columbia favorite since 1974. The Candy Factory workers create delightful gourmet chocolates here in the factory and today you will have an opportunity to view the candy making process. All the candies are made in small batches to ensure quality of the family owned and operated business. Enjoy a little shopping time while here to bring home your favorite candy.
